<u>IT TAKES A VILLAGE TO RUN A TCF MEETING</u>

What can you do to help? Based on how you are feeling, you could:

How do you feel when you hear the words, "closure, let go, move on" when well meaning people refer to your grief? Those terms will only come from people around us that have not experienced the death of a child, grandchild or sibling. These "clichés" are typically not in the vocabulary of a bereaved parent. We know you do not, "get over, let go or move on". You learn what is helpful and what is not along the journey and learn to SURVIVE. Many thanks to Annette for years of excellent newsletters. It will be tough to follow in her footsteps. If you have recommendations or corrections, Please let me know.

Several months after our son Alex died four years ago, I knew that I needed to talk with other Bereaved Parents. Our friends meant well, but their well-meaning comments just didn't help. What I found in TCF was a group of people who knew what I was going through. People who knew there was a hole in my heart. People who wanted to hear about my child and let me say his name. People who would look me in the eye and then hug me. It really helped me through a horrible time. There are a number of us who are past the first two years and still come back. There are times when we need the group (holidays and anniversaries, etc). For many of us it is also time to pay it forward: to help others as we were helped; to ease the burden if we can for other bereaved parents. Some day you may feel able to pay it forward...

On behalf of the Steering Committee, until we see each other again, we wish you peace and love, and hope that you can find a few moments of joy as you continue on your grief journey.
